## Dart Madness Finale Silent Auction Blind Draw

How to enter:

1. Fill out a bid entry form - enter your name, the name of the player you are bidding on and the amount of money you want to bid to have them as your partner on the provided sheets and put the sheet in the box. Make as many bids as you want on as many players as you want, if you win multiple bids your highest bid will be your partner. Cash only payable at 1 PM when teams are drawn.
2. Pay $\$ 10$ to enter without making a bid and a partner will be randomly drawn for you
3. Finale players - Let the tournament staff know if you for sure will be playing in the blind draw. If you are then if someone bids on you, the person who bids the most money will be your partner. It doesn't cost you anything to play. If no one bids on you and you still want to play, it's a \$10 entry and a partner will be randomly drawn for you.
4. Deadline for silent auction bids and regular entry is 12:30 PM Sunday

## Additional Rules:

1. Only the 60 finale players can be bid on, minimum bid is $\$ 10$
2. Anyone, including the 60 finale players, can make a bid. If a finale player gets a bid placed on them then that takes precedence over their own bids and any bids they made will be thrown out. You cannot bid on yourself.
3. Whoever's name is on the sheet and places the bid, that person must play in the tournament.
4. You can bid on multiple players. If you win more than one bid, you will get the person you bid the most money on. If you bid the same amount and won on more than one player, then you will pick one of your bids out of a hat. The other player(s) will go back in the pool.
5. If more than one person ties for the highest bid on a player, then the bid upon player will pick the name of one of its bidders out of a hat.
6. The four players in the main event final four are not eligible for the blind draw and all bids on them will be thrown out at 12:30 PM Sunday. Like wise any bids those 4 players made will be thrown out.
7. Any players that placed bids but did not win any bids and still wishes to play can do so by paying a \$10 entry fee.
8. Any finale players that were not bid on that still wish to play can do so by paying a $\$ 10$ entry fee.
9. All remaining players from \#7 and \#8 will be randomly drawn together as partners.
10. Payouts will be $100 \%$ of all bid money and $\$ 10$ entry money collected. Payout amounts and places will be determined by how much money is collected and how many players end up in the draw.
